- Have you noticed a change in your child's behaviors and/or attitudes?
- Are you concerned that your child may be using alcohol or other drugs?



The Student Assistance Center, a component of CARE, offers families the opportunity to receive a thorough assessment for children who are experiencing substance use or mental health problems.

Macomb County students and their families who are experiencing substance use concerns and meet certain criteria can meet with an experienced substance use/mental health counselor to gain insight into their problems and receive assistance in gaining access into the most appropriate treatment option. A sliding fee is available.

The Student Assistance Center has agreements with many Macomb County school districts and provides opportunities for the family, district personnel and CARE Student Assistance staff to work closely to follow the student throughout their substance use or mental health treatment plan.

CARE-Sponsored Teen Advocacy Groups

Teens Talking Truth (T3)

Teens who participate in a variety of prevention activities which deal with alcohol, tobacco and other drug concerns. Together they support and encourage one another to develop strong leadership and communication skills.

NicotineNarcs (NN)

An organized group of anti-tobacco student activists from high schools throughout Macomb County. Their goal is to decrease the number of establishments that provide havens for underage smoking and excessive exposure to second-hand smoke.

Skills for Managing Anger

A six-week educational series for youth experiencing difficulties because of their inability to manage their anger.

Teen Intervene

A workshop designed to provide education, support and guidance to teens that have experienced mild to moderate substance use. This program also offers parents and guardians the opportunity to learn healthy communications skills and the importance of establishing family rules surrounding substance use.

Project Focus

A FREE support program for parents and youth ages 6-15 who are either concerned about a family member's use of alcohol or other drugs or have a family member in recovery or are in recovery themselves. FREE Childcare is available for children ages 3-5. Families will learn tools to reduce their anxiety, develop healthy coping skills, learn about addiction and discover they are not alone with their concerns. The program is full of fun activities while using a skill-building approach.

Parent Education

A series of workshops using the Systematic Training for Effective Parenting (STEP) model where parents are offered a realistic and practical approach to meeting the challenges of raising children today.

Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD)

FREE presentations about prenatal alcohol and drug exposure. General overview of FASD and the life-long effects.

School-Based Prevention Programs

Paper People

Early childhood life-skills and drug prevention program that promotes ways for children to be safe and healthy.
